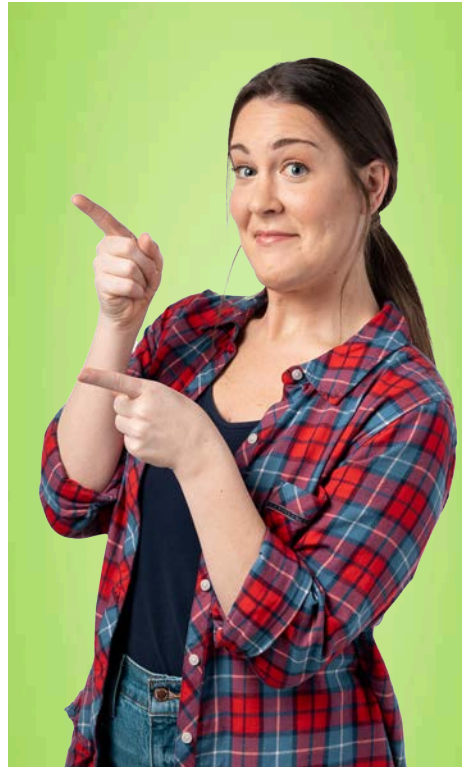
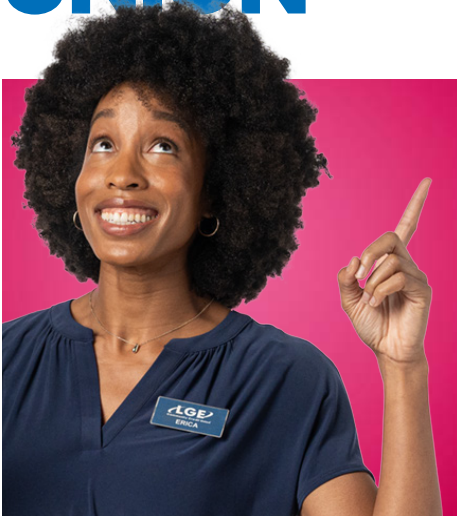
Commitment to Community
